IDUP 270. Introduction To Africana Stud. (3 Credits)

This course examines the various disciplinary and theoretical approaches to Africana Studies and its development as a field of scholarly inquiry.

Through fiction and nonfiction, students will explore topics that will include Africa and its place in the world community, the Atlantic slave trade, nationalism, Pan- Africanism, Afro centrality, and the roles of race, gender, and class in shaping the experiences of people of African descent in African and the Diaspora. Prerequisites: ENGL 110 Composition I, ENGL 111 Composition II.

IDUP 371. Study Abroad In Africa. (3-6 Credits)

An individually designed and planned learning experience at an African university.

IDUP 470. Special Topics Africana Studie. (3 Credits)

In-depth study of a selected topic in the literatures and/or languages of Africa and/or the African Diaspora. Topics will vary from semester to semester. Prerequisites: ENGL110 Composition I, ENGL 111 Composition II.
